Brief details of dispute/litigation	Please note that consequent to Hon'ble Supreme Court's Order dated 23rd October 2024 vide which it has upheld the State's authority to levy import/export fees on denatured alcohol, the Assistant Excise Commissioner of Uttar Pradesh vide his letter dated 15 th July 2025 has reinstated import/export fees on denatured alcohol by revoking its earlier Order of 2018 which had suspended import/export fees on denatured alcohol.
	Accordingly, the Assistant Excise Commissioner of Uttar Pradesh vide his letter dated 15 th July 2025 has now imposed these charges retrospectively, covering the period from FY 2019-2020 upto 15.07.2025 and quantified the amount to Rs. 21,81,12,000/- only for our Gularia unit. The company will be contesting the same.
Expected financial implications, if any, due to compensation, penalty etc.	The Excise Department has now imposed these changes retrospectively, covering the period from FY 2019-2020 upto the current date (i.e. 15.07.2025). There is no material impact financially, operationally or otherwise on the Company, except to the extent of Rs. 21,81,12,000/- as of
