Brief details of dispute/litigation	<p>Please note that consequent to Hon'ble Supreme Court's Order dated 23rd October 2024 vide which it has upheld the State's authority to levy import/export fees on denatured alcohol, the Assistant Excise Commissioner of Uttar Pradesh vide his letter dated 15th July 2025 has reinstated import/export fees on denatured alcohol by revoking its earlier Order of 2018 which had suspended import/export fees on denatured alcohol.</p> <p>Accordingly, the Assistant Excise Commissioner of Uttar Pradesh vide his letter dated 15th July 2025 has now imposed these charges retrospectively, covering the period from FY 2019-2020 upto 15.07.2025 and quantified the amount to Rs. 21,81,12,000/- only for our Gularia unit. The company will be contesting the same.</p>
Expected financial implications, if any, due to compensation, penalty etc.	<p>The Excise Department has now imposed these changes retrospectively, covering the period from FY 2019-2020 upto the current date (i.e. 15.07.2025).</p> <p>There is no material impact financially, operationally or otherwise on the Company, except to the extent of Rs. 21,81,12,000/- as of now.</p> <p>Further, the Company will be going through appropriate forums for evaluating legal recourse to be taken in the above-mentioned matter.</p>
Quantum of claims, if any	To the extent of Rs. 21,81,12,000/- sought for Gularia unit as of now.
